# (b)Professional Diploma Courses.

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Basically, one thing which the youth must understand is that all occupations in the world of work are divisible broadly into three categories:

Executive, Supervisory, Worker.

Like-wise, the pay and perks in respect of the three posts are different. And the entry qualifications prescribed for the three are also different.

The cost of time and course is also different. The higher the post, the higher is the qualifications, the lower the post the lower is the qualifications. Candidates who can invest time and money in pursuit of higher education can go for it, but those who cannot, have to make do with smaller qualifications like Diploma or certificate Courses.

The family background, the social preferences, the financial situation, the job market scenario, the no. of siblings in the family and the gender, determine the choice of the Educational level to be pursued.

Thus, if circumstances push you towards Diploma studies, then you must know what are the Diploma Courses available to the candidates like you. The world of diplomas is also curious. There are three types of Diplomas:

- Post-Matric Diplomas, which are done after SSC.
- Diplomas after Intermediate(10+2)
- PG Diplomas, which are done after Graduation (BA., B.Com B.Sc.)

Post –Matric Diplomas are offered through Polytechnics as well, as a number of other institutions set up by the Government Ministries, or affiliated to locally situated Universities. However some unscrupulous private Institutions give Post-Matric Diplomas in some skill with beautifully designed formats. They are not usually recognized by any accreditation bodies. Employers in Public Sector do not give credence to them. Plain semi-literate, experienced holders are also given such Diplomas based on general understanding of the skill and experience, after putting a Test.

Diploma Courses after intermediate are usually professional in nature and required to provide supervisory staff in the relevant field.

Post-Graduate Diplomas are in the nature of add-ons and prepare the candidate for specific job. While Graduation is treated as sign of maturity, world-wide awareness and rational outlook, the Post-graduation diploma is seen as a direction in which the individual can work in a focused manner, responsibly and independently.

# How to Choose a Course:

- 1. Selection of a course is as important as choosing a right college at post metric level.
- 2. Parents are advised to leave the decision making to their wards in choosing a course as well as college though they may counsel their children on the pathway for them.
- 3. Parents are required to encourage their children to choose a subject basing on their Aptitude, academic strength and intrest.
- 4.Students are required to have a clear understanding of their aspirations and emerging opportunities
- 5. Family background on monetary considerations may be taken in to consideration while selecting a course and how best the available resources can be utilized fully to reach to full potentiality.

Let us now look at various Diploma Courses available to the Intermediate passed candidates, stream-wise:

# i) Professional Diploma Courses after Inter (MPC):

Rehabilitation Council Of India (A Statutory Body under the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment) B-22, Qutab Institutional Area, New Delhi – 110 016 offers the following Diploma Course:

# 1. Diploma in Prosthetics & Orthotics

Prosthetics is an artificial replacement for a missing part of the human body. Examples of prosthetics (or prosthetic devices) used to restore normal function in clued artificial legs or arms fitted after amputation or artificial heart valves to replace damaged ones.

## (a) General Objective

The principle objectives of the course is the training of men and women as Prosthetists and Orthotists to meet the growing requirement for, well qualified personnel competent to undertake this very specialized type of work in the country. Prosthetist/ Orthotist is the specialist who in the exercise and pursuit of the art of prosthetics / Orthotics designs, fabricates, and fits prostheses (artificial limbs) and orthoses (Braces, supports, accessories and remedial devices for locomotor handicapped) prescribed by a clinical team headed by a Physical Medicine Specialist / Orthopaedic Surgeon.

# (b) Instructional Objective

The instructional objectives of the course is that the course contents and training given in theory and practical work in the subjects and clinical practices offered should enable the Prosthetists/ Orthotists qualified to work with Physicians, Therapists and other professionals in the field of Rehabilitation in the clinical environment. The candidates so trained should be bright, intelligent, clean-cut able to think, solve problems and apply basic principles in their work. Aiming at these objectives the course syllabus include lectures, classroom work and practical demonstration, and practical work in Prosthetic and Orthotic laboratories, during which the students are introduced to Prosthetic and Orthotic shop practices and learn the fundamentals of manufacturing, measuring and fitting of appliances. This is followed by more advanced studies in basic subjects and under direction and supervision and the students design, fabricate and fit prosthetic or orthotic appliances, as the case may be, and attend clinical meeting/conferences, demonstrations and seminars. Coaching in shop management and administration is also given to prepare them to hold such responsibilities.

# **Entry requirements:-**

a. A pass in the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in science subject, viz Physics, Chemistry, Biology and/or Mathematics.

OR

- b. A pass in the 10+2 in the vocational stream in the trade of machinist or 10+2 and I.T.I. Certificate in the trade of Fitter / Turner / Machinist / Tool or Die Maker.
- c. A pass in the final diploma examinations conducted by the Board of Technical Education of the State Govt. in Mechanical, Electrical/ or Electronics Engineering are also eligible. A minimum of 50% marks in each of the core subject will be required for admission to the course. In the case of reserved category, this may be relaxed to 45%.

# Length of the course:-

The course duration is Two Years followed by Internship of Six Months in any recognized Rehabilitation / Limb Fitting Centres. 2

Candidates are advised to carefully assess what are the skills which they can master and take up such Course only in a reputed and reliable institute. The advice of the senior people working in the field of Computers must be taken before finalizing the choice.

According to a press report published in a famous national daily,

"D. Ed. course is the new 'in thing' now" The report further says:

After the engineering bubble burst, the next hype seems to be for education training, with the demand for D. Ed. course growing.

Engineering and MBA graduates who possess the degrees but do not have jobs as they lack any employability skills find the Diploma in Education (D. Ed) as lucrative as a government job since it is 'almost guaranteed' after the two-year course.

The release of notifications for teacher posts has furthered the demand. Given the mad rush, several college managements have applied with the National Council of Teacher Education (NCTE).

While the existing number of DIET centres and private D.Ed. colleges in the State are 24 and 201 respectively, more than 1,000 applications are learnt to be with the NCTE now.

On finding the going tough and the number of takers dwindling by the passing day, several colleges which are already running engineering or MBA courses are opting for a D. Ed. course as an extra option. Similarly, local schools who find it hard to tackle the corporate onslaught are also keen on expanding their footprint.

To start a D. Ed college, all one needs is 2,500 sq. mt. of land in which the built-up area is 1,500 sq. mt., which is not difficult for existing college managements. Similarly, the endowment fund and reserve fund also cost nothing more than Rs.8 lakh.

Given the 'job assurance' with lesser risk, several engineers and MBAs are also evincing interest in joining the course.

The 'guarantee' factor has tilted the balance in favour of managements last year, when the management seats were sold for as high as Rs.1.2 lakh.

With the mushrooming of D. Ed. colleges this year, the 'pie' will now have to be shared among the players.

The problem however is with the seriousness of the managements as well as the candidates.

As school education forms the basis for a child's career, due importance has to be given to selection of candidates for training-oriented programme.

#### 2.DIPLOMA IN SANITARY INSPECTOR:

Public health is a matter of prime concern for all municipal bodies in the State. And in the scheme of things, sanitary health inspectors play an important role in protecting public health as well as the environment in a multitude of ways.

Each civic body banks heavily on its health inspectors to deal with public health issues ranging from safety of drinking water to food safety and sanitary conditions.

That is why the Sanitary Inspectors' Diploma course offered by the All-India Institute of Local Self-Government (AIILSG) has become a much-sought-after programme.

# Career openings:-

The successful completion of the Sanitary Inspectors' Diploma course can land one a sub-managerial technical position in a wide spectrum of organisations and sectors such as the State Directorate of Health Services, Public Health Department, Conservancy Department of Municipal Corporations, Council/Zilla Parishads, hotels and hospitality industry, entertainment industry, Railways, Oil refineries, Travel and Tourism and Food and Drugs Department.

Other avenues awaiting qualified sanitary inspectors have to do with sewage disposal units, water supply and disinfection units, agricultural and irrigation sectors, sugar factories, metal, chemical, textile and electrical industries, NGOs in health, education, environment and sanitation sectors and pest control agencies.

Career openings are also available for the diploma holders as health workers, multipurpose workers, vaccinators, medical assistants, treatment organisers, field assistants, junior overseers or surveyors.

The diploma holders who have successfully completed the Sanitary Inspectors' Course are already working in various capacities in the health Services, Local Bodies, Railways, Oil Refineries, Hotels and Hospitality Industries, Port Trust, Defense Establishment and Airports, Institute authorities said.

It was in 1959 January that the institute started the programme from Mumbai. Six months later, another centre was opened in Delhi in July. This was followed by the Ahmedabad, Bangalore, Belgaum, Bhopal, Kochi, Jodhpur, Nagpur, Pune, Thiruvananthapuram and Vadodara centres in cooperation with the respective State Governments and city municipal corporations.

In 1962, the Kerala Government recognised the diploma offered by the institute as an essential qualification for the recruitment of Junior Health Inspector Grade II of the Kerala Health Services Department. The institute also trains the students from the Army, the Navy and the Air Force.

# Facilities ;-

From good libraries and well-equipped laboratories for training students in elementary bacteriological, clinical, pathological work and analysis of milk and water to museums, the centres of the institute have sufficient facilities to train the students, claimed Institute officials.

Field Training programmes are organised in cooperation with Directorate of Health Services/Public Health Department and Corporations. The exposure the students receive at Urban Health Centres, Primary Health Centres and Subcentres through field postings enable them to acquire practical skills in Public Health.

Practical demonstrations are also arranged for students at infectious diseases hospitals, TB hospitals, STD clinics, maternity homes, schools, leprosy hospitals, family planning centres, water purification plants, Government dairies, slaughter houses, markets and refuse disposal sites.

#### Admission

Admission to the Sanitary Inspectors' Diploma Course is open to male and female candidates with at least a pass in standard 10.

Graduates from any stream except fine arts, undergraduates from the science stream/12th Std (passed) with science subjects/diploma holders in engineering or any technical course are admitted directly to the one-year course. In-service candidates with 10th standard pass and minimum fiver years' regular and continuous service in civic bodies, and various other agencies are also admitted directly to the one-year course. Though the medium of instruction is English, students are also taught in Hindi in certain other centres.

The application forms can be obtained from the respective centres on payment of a fee of Rs.100.

The classes start in the month of January/February and July every year for the respective courses. The course fee for the programme is Rs.8,500.

All India Institute of Local Self –Government offers Sanitary Inspectors' Diploma Course at Visakhapatnam centre. Candidates who completed graduation from any stream and class XII with Science subjects can apply for the course. The duration of course is one year. Candidates who passed class X

can also take up the course. The duration of the course for this category is 18 months. For details, log on to www.aiilsg.org

National Industrial Training Centre, New Delhi offers Health Sanitary Inspector course. The eligibility criterion is +2. The admissions are to be based upon merit and sometimes on first come basis. However all the admissions will remain provisional unless a student appear in a common entrance test conducted by Department of Training and Technical Education, Government of NCT of Delhi.

### **3.DIPLOMA IN ACCESSORY DESIGN:**

The National Institute of Fashion Design introduced the first comprehensive course in Accessory design in 1991, which covers the entire spectrum of accessories :precious and costume jewellery, leather goods, footwear, watches giftware, tableware, silverware. The program emphasizes an appreciation and application of traditional Indian craft base in a contemporary milieu. It is a three years undergraduate diploma program open to candidates who have passed the 10+2 exam with 50%marks.

#### 4.DIPLOMA IN FASHION AND WEB DESIGN:

Pearl Academy of fashion, New Delhi offers a professional Diploma in fashion and Web design of two year duration for Intermediate passed.

# Advanced Diploma in Dairy Science and Technology

The Indian dairying is emerging as an important growth leverage of Indian economy. It is the single largest contribution of agricultural sector to Indian GDP, contributing about 33% of Gross Domestic Product from agriculture. Milk production in India has increased five folds in the last fifty years and continues to be No 1 milk producing country in the world. Dairying in India continues to remain unorganized, socially oriented and driven mostly by the small animal holders comprising of small, marginal and landless milk produces. Recently there has been a marginal change in the setup with more and more entrepreneurs joining the stream. They have started units, having 50 – 100 animals, with a milk production ranging from 1000 -1500 ltrs /day. More and more people are likely to join due to the support of extended by the Government. One pertinent drawback of the new system is a lack of scientific management due to dearth of middle level professionals. Most of the entrepreneurs would like to dispose the milk as farm fresh or want to establish small processing plants to improve the revenue. Hence to man such units and also to promote personals in the dairy farm management, a human resource development programme comprising both husbandry and dairy processing is required urgently to cater to the needs of these groups. It is also expected that such trained human resource would be having good demand from outside the county Keeping in mind the above stated circumstances, a diploma in dairying of two years duration comprising the area of animal husbandry and milk processing is envisaged.
