The difference between 0 and other numbers is that all of the other numbers have a tangible visual form, whereas 0 does not. We first associate the number 0 with empty and nothing, and slowly help them understand the relation of 0 with other numbers. Make a few cards with 0 written on them. Take a set of 8-10 bowls and arrange them in a line. In a few of the bowls place a piece of candy, or any other object. 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


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

