

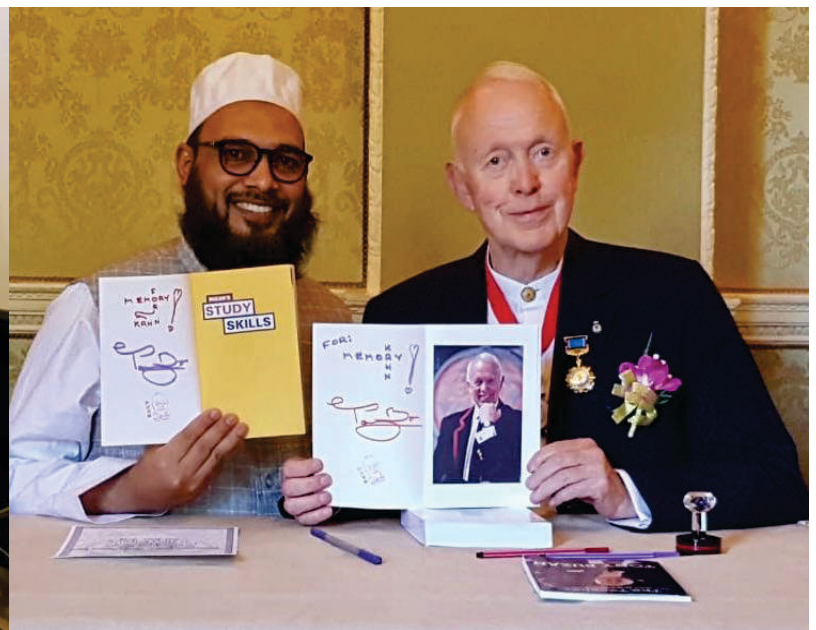
# Chairman is awarded with Senior Tony Buzan Licensed Instructor Certificate in London

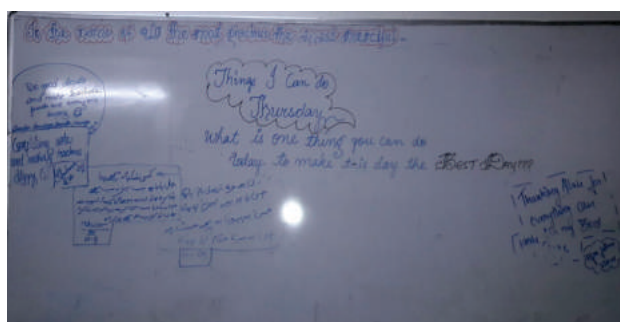
### Thinking Corner


Senior Director, Mr. Moazzam had explained the role of teachers in a unique presentation covering all the practical situations which a teacher has to face. He gave a
